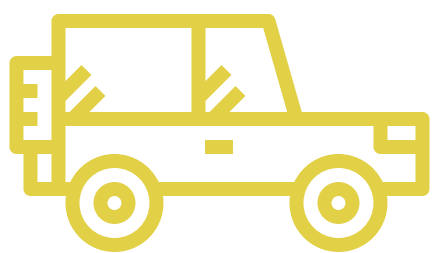

Choose Your Location Wisely And Listen!

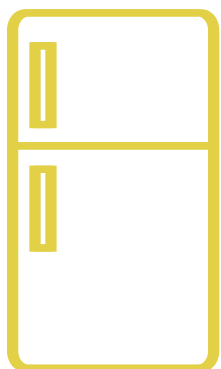
